WB 25 September 2023

The area for the temporary classrooms has been fenced off with all subterranean surveys of the site completed.

WB 02 October 2023

The contractors will move onto site and begin digging the foundations for the temporary classrooms on the City of Wolverhampton College's land.

This fortnightly bulletin will provide you with a progress update for our partial rebuild of St Peter's Collegiate Academy. It will feature any adjustments to the proposed timeline, what has been undertaken over the preceding two weeks and some photos to show the current state of the rebuild.

It has been an exciting two weeks onsite at the Academy. Last week we were visited by subcontractors to complete a survey of the site's topography, services and supply lines. The contractors onsite were fantastic with our pupils, explaining their job and how they conducted the surveys. After they left we now have lots of markings to alert other members of the construction teams what is beneath the surface.

Last week concluded with a meeting between the DfE, Keir (our appointed contractor), Three Spires Trust and the Academy to confirm the proposed timeline for construction and to begin signing off the final contract. During the construction we will be using the City of Wolverhampton College's land for the compound, access road and temporary classrooms.

Preparations for the use of this land have begun this week with the fencing being installed and the ground being mowed ready for excavations to begin next week.

As soon as the contractors move onto the site their progress will be rapid. In addition to this bulletin we will also be sharing a short video update every month following our meeting with Keir to provide further information about the progress of the build.

We anticipate that you may have some queries or concerns regarding the provision for your child. Over the coming weeks, once the work has begun, we will ensure the arrangements to move out of the A block into temporary classrooms is communicated to you in detail. Including the proposed plans for teaching and learning during this transition phase which is scheduled to take place from Wednesday, 27 March 2024.



It is truly an exciting time for the Academy as we progress to this next phase.
