WB 20 November 2023

The temporary fence around the temporary block is replaced with a permanent fence.

Since we last provided an update a lot has happened with the partial rebuild of St Peter's Collegiate Academy. We have experienced a significant increase in construction traffic which is making it more difficult for parents/ carers to access our site. We recognise that this is frustrating and apologise for the inconvenience it is causing. Over the last few weeks there has been an increase in the use of Newbridge Avenue to drop off and collect students. Please refrain from parking and turning around by the gates on Newbridge Avenue, it increases the risk of an accident while students arrive and depart the Academy. **Alternatively, please use Newbridge Crescent.**

WB 27 November 2023

The overflow car park is finished, ready for use. Decisions are made for the furnishings and fixtures of the temporary block.

The progress of the temporary block has continued with the delivery of eleven further units. As part of this construction a more permanent fence has been installed around the temporary block and the new overflow car park. During the same time period the



City of Wolverhampton College have erected permanent fences to secure their site preventing movement across the field.

Due to the restrictions on our pre-existing car parks a new 40 space overflow car park has been constructed and is now open for staff. This can also be used by our Sixth Form students and visitors, reducing the need to park on the road opposite the Academy. This additional space for parking was necessary to allocate the necessary space on the main car park to construct a temporary reception and administration block. The service trenches are underway before the area is prepared for the temporary units to be installed. Once this is open in April 2024 more car parking will be made available. Kier our constructors have maintained access to the sports hall and changing facilities. Therefore, if our students require access for enrichment activities or sports clubs they can still access the site via the sports hall entrance.

12 January 2026

The new Academy block replacing A-block will be open to pupils.

Finally, we met with Chalk Associates to specify the furniture and fixings for the temporary block. Discussions are soon to commence for the permanent block, if you would like to become involved in these future discussions I will share further information in a bulletin after Christmas.
