### June 2024

Management of A Block transfers to Kier

**We have now occupied the temporary block for six weeks, and it has become familiar to students and staff. During this time, we have adjusted the layout of the classrooms, purchased additional furniture, and continued to dispose of resources no longer required. This has been to ensure our use of the temporary facilities are optimised, whilst also allowing staff to continue preparations for moving into the new building in January 2026.**

Preparations for the demolition of A Block are progressing well. Surveys are now complete, and materials are being removed in readiness for the demolition. By



the end of June 2024, A Block (Old Block) will be under demolition, with materials being removed from the site and then recycled. This phase seems to be progressing quite slowly due to most of the work taking place inside the building. However, over the last week, large machinery has been delivered which will be used to process the materials and take them away from site. This has been

scheduled to minimise the disruption to terminal exams which is why progress is slower.

Over the next few weeks, the fencing around the Old Block will slowly be replaced with solid, wooden hoardings displaying Kier's logo. At this point, the building site will be managed separately from the Academy and its day-to-day operations. As we progress through the project, we will provide further news.
