### June 2024

Demolition of A Block commences

It has been a while since I provided an update about our partial rebuild of St Peter's Collegiate Academy. Despite this, work has continued at pace. Initially, from the exterior, little has changed while sub-contractors removed, sorted and recycled materials from the building's interior. Over the preceding eight weeks, a substantial amount of work has taken place to remove the timber, metal and wiring prior to recycling and reuse.

During the half term break, Kier erected an 8ft hoarding to act as a physical barrier, separating the partial rebuild from the academy site. This is to ensure that both areas can be safely operated. However, there is still opportunity for our students to see the progress of the build from vantage points at the top of our school site.

On Monday 17th June 2024, Garvey (the demolition subcontractors) began the controlled demolition of the 'old block', known to our students as 'A block'. Completed by a team of skilled workers, they have begun the process of razing the site to the ground. While the workers use heavy machinery to dismantle the building and sort the materials for removal, the water cannon is being used to prevent dust from hanging in the air and moving across our site. In just four days, they have totally removed the design & technology section of the block and are scheduled to have removed the entire building by July 2024.

### End of July 2024

If you visit the site over the coming weeks, you are likely to have a very different view as the old building is slowly removed. Consequently, during this period, you are also likely to experience difficulties accessing our site during the day due to increased construction traffic. Parking is also extremely difficult, and I would encourage visitors to our site to observe the parking restrictions and to park either in our main or overflow car parks.

It is an exciting time for the academy community. Our partial rebuild is a fantastic opportunity for our students and staff. It will be a hugely transformative experience, providing many learning opportunities.
