Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to share with you the arrangements for our upcoming **Sports Day**, taking place on **Tuesday, 24 June 2025**. Following the success of last year's event, we will once again be holding the day at **Aldersley Leisure Village**, giving students in Years 7, 8, and 9 the opportunity to experience inclusive athletics in a professional stadium setting.

This event is designed to be fully inclusive, with all students contributing—regardless of perceived ability—through active participation and by supporting their form group and wider house team. Our aim is to promote physical activity, teamwork, and enjoyment, creating a memorable experience for all. With guidance from their form tutors and PE staff, students will prepare for the day by planning their teams and events in advance.

Key Information

- Arrival: Students should arrive at St Peter's Academy at the usual time (8.30am), wearing their full St Peter's PE kit and suitable trainers.
- Departure: Students will be registered in their form groups at 8:30am, then travel by coach to Aldersley Stadium, with events beginning by 9:45am.

What Students Need to Bring

- A packed lunch and non-carbonated drinks (e.g. water) for the day.
- Students eligible for free school meals will be provided with a vegetarian packed lunch. If your child has specific dietary needs, please contact hmcglynn@stpetersacademy.org.uk by Monday, 16 June.
- A St Peter's tracksuit top or blazer to keep warm between events.
- Weather-appropriate items, including a waterproof jacket, sunscreen and a hat.

End-of-Day Arrangements

- Events will conclude at approximately 13:45pm, with coaches departing Aldersley Leisure Village from 14:00pm.
- Upon arrival back at St Peter's, students will be dismissed directly from the coach and will not re-enter the academy.

- Return times may vary slightly due to staggered coach departures; some students may return as early as 14:20pm.
- If you would prefer your child to remain at school until 15:00pm, please inform us in advance so that arrangements can be made.

To help coaches access the site safely between 14:00pm and 15:00pm, we kindly ask parents to avoid parking on Compton Park Road during this period.

Attendance and Participation

Please note that **attendance at Sports Day is compulsory**. The academy's standard attendance policy applies. If your child has a short- or long-term injury or condition that prevents them from taking part, please contact hmcglynn@stpetersacademy.org.uk or their Head of Year as soon as possible.

These students will be given leadership roles such as supporting timekeeping, recording results, or assisting staff.

Additional Information

- Unfortunately, **parents are unable to attend** the event due to venue capacity and the number of students and staff involved. However, we will be sharing highlights throughout the day on the academy's social media platforms.
- As with a typical school day, **mobile phones should not be used during the event**. Students may bring phones to contact home before or after school hours, but these must remain in their bags throughout the event. The academy is not responsible for any lost or unattended items.
- In the unlikely event of **cancellation due to adverse weather**, a message will be sent via email or text. Should this occur, students should attend the academy prepared for a regular school day.

Please also ensure that your emergency contact details held by the academy are up to date.
