Dear Parents and Carers,

## Re: Guidance on Optional Virtual Provision for Students During Partial School Closure

When the school is partially closed during our move into the new build, we would like to encourage all students to continue engaging with their learning at home.

Teachers have provided a range of **optional tasks and activities** designed to help students consolidate their knowledge and stay connected with their subjects. These tasks can be found in the documents attached below.

For **KS3 students**, the focus of the work is on **project-based and cross-curricular learning**. Students can choose which tasks they would like to complete from the selection provided, allowing them to explore subjects in creative and independent ways.

For **KS4 students**, the work provided focuses on **revision and exam preparation**. Departments have shared specific guidance, links, and resources to support effective revision. For **KS5 students**, the work focuses on **tasks prepared by their class teachers** to support their learning in their chosen courses. Students are encouraged to use this time to consolidate key concepts, complete independent study tasks, and prepare for assessments in line with their course requirements.

We would also encourage all students to ensure their **careers work is up to date**, including completing the **Future Skills Questionnaire** (emailed directly to them by the Careers and Enterprise Company) and the **Unifrog 101 course**, which can be accessed through their school Unifrog account. This will help them continue to explore post-school options and develop important skills for their future pathways.

We have also attached a **wellbeing guide** which signposts your child to support for their mental health if needed. We encourage students to make use of these resources and to reach out for help if they are feeling anxious or overwhelmed. While completing this work is **not compulsory**, we strongly encourage students to take part where possible. When we return to school in January, students will be able to **show their work to their form tutors or class teachers**, who will be awarding **Class Charts points** to recognise their effort and commitment.
