Option Process – courses can only run if enough students pick them

- Students will have access to an online Google form that will guide you through completing your choices. (see next page).
1. Pick one option from List A, these are limited to (History, Geography, Spanish and Computing)
 2. Pick two options from List B, an extended list and includes Separate Science*
 3. Pick two options from List C, an extended list and includes Separate Science*
- *Limited offers: Separate science (invite)
 - Art/Photography or GCSE PE/CTEC PE cannot both be taken



• Opting Process:

1. An email will be sent to parents/carers to inform them the process is starting and how to support you.
1. An email will be sent to student school email accounts with instructions and also the options form to complete.
1. Once completed, the form will close and remain closed – so make sure the choices made are correct.



- Block A – pick one subject
- Block B – Pick two options (a first and then a second choice)
- Block C - Pick two options (a first and then a second choice)
- If separate science is a preferred option then it should be opted for. There will be a formal assessment to ensure this is the correct choice and it is not guaranteed.
