Re: Year 11 Examination Arrangements and End-of-Year Key Dates

As we move into the examination period, I am writing to share the arrangements we have put in place to support Year 11 students over the coming weeks.

Daily Routine and Timings

From Monday 11 May, Year 11 will swap lunch slots with Year 9, moving to a 12.20 pm - 1.00 pm lunch break. This adjustment ensures that afternoon examinations can begin promptly.

During the week commencing 1 June, students will be able to leave the school site at 2.00 pm each day to allow additional time for independent revision at home.

Attendance and Study Leave

Students are expected to attend school as normal until Friday 5 June. Official study leave begins on Monday 8 June, from which point students are required to attend only for their scheduled examinations.

From 8 June, optional revision sessions will be available across a range of subjects, delivered by members of staff. While attendance is not compulsory, we strongly encourage students to make use of these sessions, particularly in subjects where they feel they would benefit from additional support. A full timetable is attached, and we will resend the weekly schedule each Friday throughout the exam period. Before and after school revision sessions will also run across the entire examination period.

Examination Day Expectations

Free toast will be available in the canteen from 8.00 am on examination days. Students must be at the exam hall by 8.50 am, and full school uniform is required for all examinations and revision sessions.

Leavers' Events

We look forward to marking this important milestone with our Year 11 students through the following events:

- **Leavers' Service** – Tuesday 16 June at 11.20 am, St Jude's Church. Attendance is compulsory and students should wear full school uniform.
- **Year 11 Prom** – Thursday 3 July at Grand Central, City Centre. Arrivals from 6.30 pm; the evening concludes at 11.00 pm. All prom payments must be made by the end of Friday 8 May.

We are proud of everything our Year 11 students have achieved during their time at St Peter's. The arrangements outlined above are designed to give them every opportunity to perform at their very best.
