

Uniform Required

A blazer or V-neck jumper with the St Peter's logo must be worn. Students may choose **either or both**. Hoodies, sweatshirts or jackets must not be worn instead of these items.

- Plain black V-neck jumper with academy badge - No hoodies, sweatshirts or PE kit



- Black school blazer with academy badge



- Plain white shirt

- **Either** - Plain black formal trousers (leggings, jeans or skinny fit are not allowed). These must be worn with plain black socks. Through hot weather periods, smart, tailored shorts can be worn instead. Again, no denim, jersey or 'lycra' material.

• Headwear for religious reasons only – e.g. Patka/Turban/Hijab – Must be plain black.	
• A warm coat - water/showerproof recommended. No hoodies/sweatshirts or denim jackets should be worn at school. These will be confiscated if they are seen in school.	

Please ensure that all items are clearly labelled in case they are misplaced.

A smart, professional appearance is required at all times:

- Shirts must be neatly tucked in
- No under-garments should be visible above trousers
- Only one pair of trousers should be worn at a time
- Top buttons should be fastened and ties must be done up over the top button
- Discreet make-up is allowed
- Nail varnish and false nails are not allowed. Nails should be short and clean, for health and safety reasons
- False eyelashes are not permitted
- Facial/tongue piercings are not permitted
- We allow a plain metal stud earring in the lobe of each ear and a traditional wristwatch. No smart watches or other jewellery is allowed
- A warm, preferably waterproof coat is recommended, but it must be removed in classrooms
- Hats are not permitted in the school building
- Long hair must be tied up for PE and DT for health and safety purposes

PE Kit Required:

- Navy blue polo t-shirt with **academy logo**
- Long-sleeved navy-blue tracksuit top with **academy logo**
- Navy shorts/skort, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue football socks or white ankle socks
- Trainers
- Football boots
- Shin Pads
- **Optional** base layer underneath the school PE kit of white, grey, black or blue may also be worn
- To avoid any potential injury, all jewellery must be removed while students take part in PE, and Karas must be covered with a sweat band.

Students must change into their PE kit at school. No items of PE kit should be worn underneath the formal school uniform.

We will endeavour to remedy any uniform issues in school so that students can engage fully in learning. We will provide spare items of uniform, if possible (these items will probably be 'preloved'). However, we may ask for parental support when items need to be brought into school.

Failure to comply with instructions regarding uniform will result in sanctions being applied. Items which are not permitted will be confiscated and should be collected from Reception at the end of the school day, in the first instance. Repeated instances will result in items being returned to students after a longer period, depending on the circumstances.
