Dear Parents and Guardians,

Compton Park Traffic Arrangements

I hope you have had a wonderful summer break. We look forward to welcoming all students back to St Peter's for the new academic year.

As you will be aware, in addition to being the home of St Peter's, Compton Park is also used by St Edmund's Academy and Wolverhampton Wanderers FC. As a result, it is a very busy site and can become particularly congested at the beginning and end of the school day.

The safety of our students is our highest priority. Therefore, I am writing to ask for your cooperation in helping to ensure that students can arrive at and leave school safely.

At present, Compton Park is a cul-de-sac with no access through to Newbridge Crescent. **Consequently, vehicle access beyond the Wolverhampton Wanderers training ground entrance will not be permitted between 8.15am and 8.45am and between 2.45pm and 3.15pm each school day.**

Where possible, we would encourage families to avoid travelling by car to Compton Park during these times. When car transport is necessary, vehicles should not proceed beyond the turning circle, as the entrance to the Wolves training ground also experiences significant traffic at these times.

These arrangements are illustrated on the attached map.

Thank you for your support and cooperation in helping us to maintain a safe environment for all students, staff and visitors.
